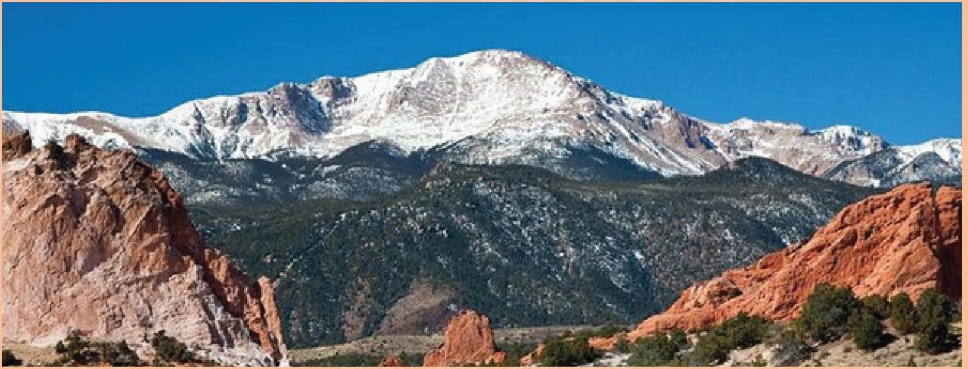

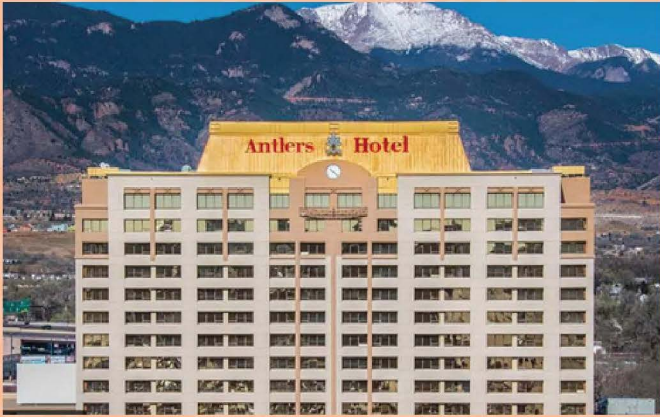

One time pet fee of \$50.00 per room (plus all applicable taxes) for up to 2 dogs and an additional \$50.00 per dog for a maximum of 4 dogs in the room, no bigger than 50lbs each. Each guest must sign a pet agreement at check-in.

Antlers ("A Wyndham Hotel") PET AGREEMENT

(This Agreement applies to domesticated pets other than Service Animals)

In consideration for the Hotel permitting me to keep my pet in the room assigned to me, I hereby agree to the following:

1. My pet is a domesticated dog that weighs no more than 50 lbs.
2. No more than four pets are permitted in my guest room.
3. I agree to pay a US\$50.00 (plus applicable taxes) non-refundable per stay service fee for up to two pets and an additional \$50 fee for additional pets, up to four maximum. I understand that additional fees may apply in the event my pet causes any damage.
4. I must keep my pet restrained on a leash or in a pet carrier when my pet is outside my guest room.
5. I must properly remove and dispose of any litter or waste associated with my pet on Hotel premises.
6. I understand that pets are not permitted in Hotel restaurants or other Hotel food and beverage areas or the pool area.
7. I understand that if my pet is in the guest room, my pet must be caged and I must be present while my room is serviced by anyone (i.e., housekeeper, engineer, room service, etc.).
8. I agree to pay the Hotel any charges for any necessary cleaning or repair due to pet stains and/or damage, as incurred or alleged to be incurred by any guest, employee or invitee of the Hotel. I hereby authorize my credit card on record to be charged for the cost of these additional services.
9. I agree that I am responsible for the noise my pet creates and will ensure that my pet does not disrupt the quiet enjoyment of other hotel guests.
10. I agree that should the Hotel determine in its sole discretion that my pet is objectionable to other hotel guests, I must immediately make other arrangements to house the pet outside the Hotel.
11. I release the Hotel from any and all liability for any injury and/or damage suffered by my pet.
12. I agree that I assume full responsibility for any injury or damage caused or alleged to be caused by my pet and incurred or alleged to be incurred by any guest, employee or invitee of the Hotel. I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Hotel Entities from and against any and all alleged or actual losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees and court costs) suffered by the Hotel Entities or asserted by any other hotel guest, invitee employee or person arising out of or in connection with my pet's stay at the Hotel.
13. I understand and agree that the Hotel retains the right to exclude my pet if in the Hotel's sole discretion my pet is considered dangerous by reason of size, disposition or is likely to frighten or harm other guests of the Hotel.
14. I confirm that my pet has all the required up to date vaccinations and inoculations and does not have any communicable illnesses or diseases.

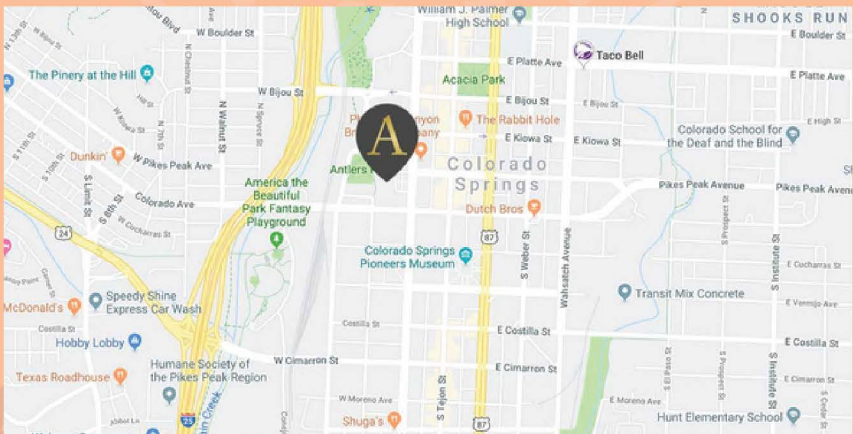

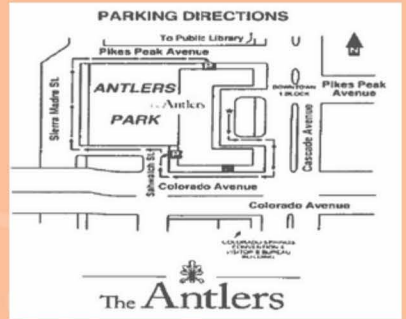

The parking garage has an 6ft 8in clearance.
It is easiest to enter from Pikes Peak Ave. Please take a ticket from the dispenser and bring it inside with you.
When you are ready to leave, take your ticket to the front desk where there is a ticket validation machine, and validate it. Please use that same ticket to exit to avoid paying each time you enter and exit. To note, once validated, the ticket becomes magnetized and having it close to a credit card or cell phone can demagnetize it. The nightly \$8 parking charge will get posted to each reservation.

The 10+ Commandments of a National Specialty

1. Thou shalt watch, applaud and cheer all Junior Showmanship classes. They are the future of our breed and our club.
2. Thou shalt remind those who appear stressed to breathe.
3. Thou shalt keep your grooming area clean.
4. Thou shalt keep your dog by your side and under control at all times.
5. Thou shalt pick up after your dog at all times.
6. Thou shalt know and follow any Show Committee rules or requests. Thou shalt particularly pay attention to where the hotel has designated "No Dogs" and which activities are not dog-inclusive.
7. Thou shalt bid as much money as possible at the auctions supporting the next National and Tibetan Terrier Health and Welfare.
8. Thou shalt applaud every winner (individual classes, Winners, Best in whatever, High in whatever).
9. Thou shalt applaud every entrant in the Veterans classes.
10. In any class where a cut is made, thou shalt applaud as the excused dogs leave the ring.
11. Thou shalt watch obedience and other companion/performance events.
12. Thou shalt congratulate all winners.
13. If Thou cannot say something nice, thou shalt not say anything at all. This applies to any dog or any person for the duration of the show.
14. Thou shalt welcome all newcomers to your breed. You never know who will later be a puppy buyer, mentor, best friend or judge.
15. Thou shalt strike up a friendly conversation with the pet owner who drops by with their dog, even if that dog will never see the inside of a show ring.
16. Thou shalt thank the committee members and event workers who are hosting and working at the current year's Specialty. Thou shalt also help the show committee when asked or when an opportunity presents itself.
17. Thou shalt be courteous to your fellow exhibitors at all times.
18. Thou shalt enjoy the fact that you are with the breed you love – and are going home with the best dog there – your own!
