Entries must be received by 12:00 pm CST Wednesday, August 14th, 2024, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

#### Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial EXCEPT that if cancellation is necessary due to COVID-19, entrants will receive full refunds. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 262-500-4080, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. Payment <u>must</u> include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.

Online entries: Go to caper-dogs.com and click on the Online Entry link.

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

<u>Transfers to Best of Breed & higher Obedience or Rally classes:</u> Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Obedience & Rally entries can be transferred to the next higher level in the given entered program. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary <u>at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging</u> for the show.

#### Non-Regular Classes (Single Dog Entries)

**Veteran Dog/Bitch Classes** – for Dogs and Bitches 7 years but not 9, those 9 years but not 11, those 11 years but not 13 or those 13 years and over, both sexes. The winners of these classes are eligible for Best of Breed, provided they have not been defeated in another class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered.

#### Non-Regular Classes (Multiple Dog Entries, National Specialty Only)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class** – Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) and are shown with *at least two, but not more than four* of their offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excusals. Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class. Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class – For two Tibetan Terriers with at least one owner in common. Both dogs must be entered in another class to qualify for the additional class entry fee.

**Breeders Class** – For three to five Tibetan Terriers with at least one breeder in common. Requirements are as follows:

- 1. The breeder must be present to accept the award,
- All of the three to five TTs in the entry must be entered in another regular or non-regular competition class at the National Specialty (Agility, Rally, Obedience, Breed, Sweepstakes/ Veteran Sweepstakes, and or Futurity Stakes).
- 3. The three to five TTS that are exhibited in the Breeder's Class must represent more than one litter and cannot all have identical parentage.
- 4. The Breeder is not required to personally exhibit any of the Tibetan Terriers in his/her entry.
- 5. Each Tibetan Terrier must have its own exhibitor/handler.

**Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, Best Puppy and Best Veteran:** All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor classes are eligible for the Best Bred By Exhibitor awards. Best Bred by Exhibitor will be chosen from the first-place exhibits from the four Bred-by classes. Best Puppy and Best Veteran will be chosen in the same manner, from the first-place exhibits in each Puppy (6-9 month, 9-12 month and Bred-by 6-12 month) and Veteran Class.

**Points for Reserve Available:** At each Regional and National Specialty, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's Sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the events are held.

#### **AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

## DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book, and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner\*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best Of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of
  Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best
  of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible winner.
- If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select
  Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National AKC
  Owner-Handled Series.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.

#### FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

#### Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

#### Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but
  must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate
  cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may
  not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**Novice Class** – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class** – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

# NATIONAL SPECIALTY - FUTURITY STAKES (Wednesday Only)

#### Requirements & Classification

The Futurity Stakes will be held in conjunction with the National Specialty. An eligible dog may be entered up to three times in its lifetime, once per age class. An entry awarded the title of Grand Futurity Winner, regardless of age class, may not compete in subsequent Futurity Stakes. Dogs must be handled by the entry's Breeder, Owner, a member of their immediate household, or an amateur substitute - defined as a person who has not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

The Futurity program is open only to individual dogs or litters that have been nominated at least 2 weeks prior to close of entries and have received approval and a Futurity certificate number from the Futurity Chairperson. Breeders must remain in good standing throughout the Futurity process, or their nomination(s) and Futurity Stakes eligibility will be forfeited. Dogs shown in the Futurity Stakes must be 6 months of age or older, and also be entered in one of the regular Classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate Futurity Stakes class, with the age division, in the space provided for "Additional Classes" on the entry form.



- 1 (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, snooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
